WEEK ONE

Saturate with Adoration/Praise

Day 1: Habakkuk 2:14

Day 3: Psalm 40:3

Praise God for putting a new song in our mouths. He is worthy of our Praise!

Day 5: Psalm 139:14

Day 6: Psalm 148:13

Praise God for His name is exalted and His majesty is above earth and heaven!

Day 7: Psalm 150:6

WEEK TWO

Saturate with Confession/Repentance

Day 1: Psalm 139:23-24

Ask God to search you and know you. Do you need to confess any thoughts, feelings, attitudes or actions that have displeased Him?

Day 2: Psalm 19:14

Are the words of your mouth and the deep longings of your heart pleasing to God?

Day 3: 2 Chronicles 7:14

Humble yourself, pray, seek God's face and turn from any wicked way God has revealed to be true about your life.

Day 4: Ephesians 6:10-13

Pray, acknowledging that your struggle is not a physical one but a spiritual one. Take your stand against devil and his schemes.

Day 5: Ephesians 6:14-20

Pray, putting on the individual pieces of spiritual armor God has provided for us. We are in a spiritual battle! Take your stand in Christ's victory!

Day 6: Hebrews 12:1-3

Confess anything that is hindering your relationship with God. Repent of any known sin. Persevere as you follow Jesus.

Day 7: 1 John 1:9

As you have confessed your sin, know that God not only forgives you but He cleanses you from all unrighteousness. Thank Him for this great news!

WEEK THREE

Saturate with Thanksgiving

Day 1: Psalm 100:4

Begin your time with the Lord today by thanking Him for the blessings He has given you. Thank Him for answering specific prayers you have prayed.

Day 2: 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

Give thanks even in the bad circumstances of your life. God is there. He cares. He can bring good things out of bad circumstances.

Day 3: Psalm 111:1

Pray, giving thanks to God with your whole heart. Share this thanksgiving with another believer. Let them rejoice in the good God has done for you.

Day 4: 2 Corinthians 9:15

Pray, giving thanks to God for His inexpressible gift – Jesus!

Day 5: 1 Chronicles 16:34

Pray, giving thanks to the Lord for His goodness and His steadfast love that will last forever.

Day 6: Psalm 30:4-5

Pray, giving thanks to God for showing us His favor. Thank Him for the joy we have in Him.

Day 7: 1 Corinthians 15:55-57

Pray, thanking God for the victory over death and sin that we have through Jesus.

WEEK FOUR

Saturate with Supplication

Day 1: Ephesians 5:18

Ask God to fill you with His Spirit. Ask, seek and knock. Tell God that you want Him to have complete control of your life. Seek to be led by the Spirit, not by your flesh.

Day 2: Luke 10:2

Pray, asking God to raise up workers in His harvest. Ask Him to call people to serve as pastors, missionaries, and preschool, children's ministry, and student ministry workers.

Day 3: Matthew 28:18-20

Pray committing yourself to be part of the church's great work of making disciples who will follow Jesus, be baptized and be taught to obey King Jesus. Commit to becoming a disciple maker who will make other disciple makers.

Day 4: Romans 12:1-2

Daily pray offering your body as a living sacrifice to God. Surrender to Him and His plan for your day. Pray to be transformed by the renewing of your mind through scripture. Commit to doing God's will.

Day 5: John 15:5-8

Stay closely connected to Jesus through prayer and reading His word. Pray boldly for God to answer big prayers that would bring Him glory. Pray that your obedience would bear much fruit.

Day 6: Acts 1:8

Pray for God to put people on your mind that you need to tell about Jesus. Ask Him if you should go on any of our church mission trips this year or in the years to come.

Day 7: Ephesians 3:20-21

Pray, asking God to do things only He can do! When people see them, they will know it is God who answers prayer! Consider setting your alarm for 3:20 pm each day as a reminder to pray to see things only God can do.
